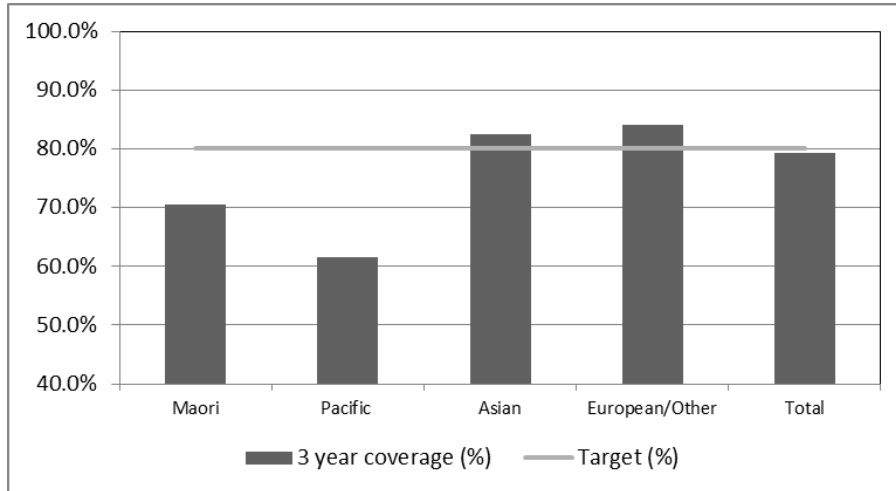




1. NCSP coverage – Lakes DHB Region – 31 March 2014 quarter

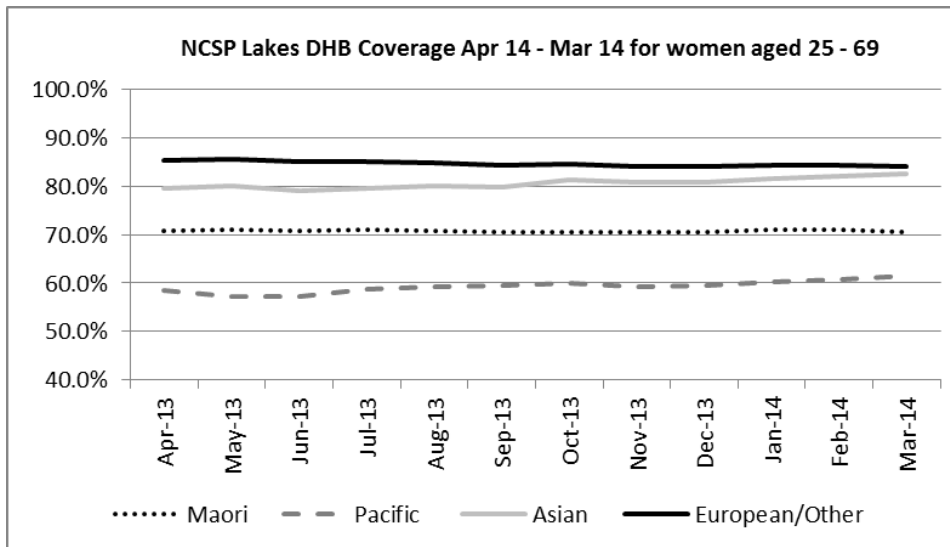
