Abstract format

Please limit your abstracts to 400 words. A guideline for formatting is below. If you use a different format, please ensure your information is clearly presented.

Title:

Authors: *(please indicate who will present on the day with a *)*

Issue: *Explain the screening issue being addressed.*

Aims: *State what you wanted to achieve.*

Methods/Actions: *Specify what you did and how you did it.*

Results/Achievements: *Describe what you found or what was achieved.*

Conclusions/Implications: *Explain what your work or study means for your organisation or others, specify recommendations or suggest what you would do differently next time. Consider listing a set of practice points.*

Presentation options

- Oral presentation – 15 minutes (10 for presentation +5 for questions)
- Poster
 - Posters can be submitted that have previously been presented elsewhere.

Abstract review process

All abstracts will be reviewed by the programme committee. Authors will be notified by email whether their papers have been accepted or declined by 1 August 2016.

Selection criteria

1. Relevance: Paper has a good fit with the hui / themes

2. Outcomes: Clear outcomes are described
3. Interest: Paper addresses an issue that is highly topical, presents innovative practice, and addresses an area of interest to the hui audience
4. Quality: Well-structured, specific, detailed and can be delivered within the timeframe.
